RESEARCH IN NATIONAL LABORATORIES

- 68, SHRI SITARAM JAIPURIA: Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that while inaugurating the Conference of Directors of the National Laboratories held in Lucknow on the 5th December, 1964, he stated that the research in national laboratories was not encouraging although crores of rupees were being spent on them;
- (b) if so, what are the reasons for the results of scientific research emanating from the national laboratories are not encouraging; and
- (c) what remedial measures are being taken in this respect?

MINISTER OF **EDUCATION** (SHRI M. C. CHAGLA):(a) No, Sir. What I said was that it was the duty of every Director of a National Laboratory to remove the prevailing misunderstanding that results emanating from National Laboratories were not encouraging. I advised the Directors to give special attention to this and keep the public informed of the results they had produced, how they were useful to the country, how they had helped in industrial development and saving of foreign exchange etc. etc.
