tfTHE MINISTER OF COMMERCE (SHRI MANUBHAI SHAH): (a) and (b) There has not been any significant increase in the price of woollen cloth in the current winter season compared to the general rise in prices. While a substantial portion of the small foreign exchange allocation for the import of raw wool has been earmarked for defence supplies, the increase in prices is largely due to shortage of imported wool.]

INTRODUCTION OF DIESEL LOCOMOTIVES ON DELHI-MADRAS ROUTE

- (a) whether it is a fact that proposals have been finalised to introduce diesel locomotives from 1st January, 1966 on the Delhi-Madras route; and

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (DR. RAM SUBHAG SINGH): (a) No.

(b) It has been tentatively planned to dieselise Southern Express/Air-conditioned Express trains only between Madras and Delhi during 1966, as soon as maintenance facilities are created on this route and sufficient number of diesel locomotives are available, after meeting the requirements of goods traffic.
