THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTER OF COMMERCE (SHRI S. V. RAMASWAMY): (a) and (b) The International wool Secretariat in its Report on the "Economics of Modernisation in the Indian Textile Industry" Wool inter alia recommended the establishment of a strategic reserve, or stock-pile of imported raw materials on which manufacturers can draw against export orders with the minimum delay and formality. Government have accepted this recommendation and are examining the possibility of importing about 5 million lbs of wool from Australia for building up an effective stock-pile along with the modernisation scheme.
