

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI L. N. MISHRA): (a) and (b) A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT

(a) Premises of 61 licensed wholesale and retail foodgrain dealers and dealers of essential commodities were raided by the police in collaboration with the Civil Supplies Department, Delhi and 81 persons were arrested. Out of the 61 cases, one case has been completed and has ended in conviction. The punishment awarded was imprisonment till the rising of the court, a fine of Rs. 2501- and confiscation of 13 bags of wheat involved.

Except for the 13 bags of wheat confiscated in the case which resulted in conviction, other quantities of various commodities recovered are held in safe custody for disposal in accordance with the orders of the court.

REPORT OF THE INDIAN OLYMPIC TEAM

*107. SHRI U. S. DUGAL: Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have received any report about the working of Indian Olympic Team and their achievements at the Tokyo Olympic Games; and

(b) if so, what is the reaction of the Government thereto?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SHRI BHAKT DARSHAN): (a) No formal report has so far been received; but the Government are aware of the performance of the Indian Olympic contingent at Tokyo.

(b) Government's reaction is as under: —

- (1) *Hockey*.—The Indian hockey team has done well in winning the Gold Medal and reestablishing India's supremacy in hockey.
- (2) *Athletics, wrestling and weightlifting*.—The performance was not altogether unsatisfactory.
- (3) *Shooting*.—The performance was below our expectations.
- (4) *Gymnastics, cycling and diving*.—The performance was poor.
