Establishment of Jain Temple at Brahmi Village in U.P.

SHRIMATI SAVITA SHARDA:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether any representation has been received by Government regarding Jain temple being established at Brahmi village at Badrinath Hills in Uttar Pradesh;

(b) whether it is also a fact that some pandas in the area of Badrinath Hills are creating problem and obstructing establishment of a Jain Dharamshala and temple; and

(c) if so, what steps Government are taking to protect temple and allow Jains to have pran pritishta of Jain Idol Adinath on the 11th August, 2000?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI I.D. SWAMI): (a) to (c) As per the report received from Govt. of UP, permission had been given by the concerned local authority to Shri Shwetambar Jain Trust to construct a prayer hall only, at Badrinath. However, there was opposition and resentment/tension among the local community comprising the Pandas, traders and Saints on the construction of a Jain Temple, for which, permission had not been granted. However, with the intervention of the District Administration, the matter has been resolved amicably and the idol of Shri Adinath, the Jain diety, has been taken to Haridwar.
