

**STRIKE IN GANDHI MEDICAL COLLEGE,
BHOPAL**

*775. THAKUR BHANU PRATAP SINGH: Will the Minister of HEALTH be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the students getting Central scholarships in Gandhi Medical College, Bhopal, have gone on strike; and

(b) if so, the reasons therefor and the steps taken to avert the same?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH (DR. SUSHILA NAYAR): (a) and (b) Certain students studying at the Gandhi Medical College, Bhopal, and receiving scholarships from the Central Government absented themselves on one or, more dates on the 27th November, and 5th and 7th December, 1964 apparently in sympathy with the demands of the internees and housemen in medical colleges in Delhi and Maharashtra. The strike has since been called off through efforts made at different levels.

*776. SHRI RAM SAHAI: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state the measures if any, adopted to check unauthorised expenditure running into crores of rupees in excess of the grants made by Parliament, incurred by various Ministries?]

योजना मंत्री (श्री बी. आर. भगत) :

संसद् द्वारा दिये गये अनुदानों पर नियंत्रण रखने वाले प्राधिकारियों के लिए यह आवश्यक है कि वे इस बात का ध्यान रखें कि अनुदानों से अधिक रकम तब तक खर्च न की जाय जब तक उसके लिए अनुपूरक अनुदान या समेकित निधि से अग्रिम न प्राप्त कर लिया गया हो ।

†[THE MINISTER OF PLANNING (SHRI B. R. BHAGAT): The authorities controlling the grants made by Parliament are required to ensure that the grants are not exceeded except after obtaining a Supplementary Grant or an advance from the Contingency Fund.]

STENOGRAPHERS OF L.I.C.

*777. SHRI RAM SINGH: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that 600 Stenographers of the Life Insurance Corporation of India have submitted a memorandum to the Prime Minister urging his intervention in the matter of revision of their pay scales which are much below than those of their counterparts working in Central Government; and

(b) if so, what are Government's reaction in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF PLANNING (SHRI B. R. BHAGAT): (a) The All India Life Insurance Corporation Stenographers' Association have submitted a memorandum to the Prime Minister regarding the revision of their pay scales, etc. A copy of the memorandum has been endorsed to the Life Insurance Corporation also.

(b) The matter concerns the Life Insurance Corporation and not the Government.
