

**SUBSIDIARY CENTRES FOR LEPROSY**

\*778. SHRI M. P. BHARGAVA: Will the Minister of HEALTH be pleased to state:

(a) the present number of subsidiary centres for Leprosy with their locations in the various States;

(b) the progress made to control leprosy in the country through these centres;

(c) the extent of population covered by these centres; the number of persons examined and the number of patients under treatment; and

(d) whether Government propose to intensify the anti-leprosy campaign in the Fourth Plan?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH (DR. SUSHILA NAYAK): (a) There are at present 164 Leprosy Control Units, previously designated differently as Leprosy Control Units, Leprosy Subsidiary Centres and Leprosy Treatment and Study Centres, functioning in the country. A statement giving the location of these units in the various States is laid on the Table of the Sabha. [See Appendix L, Annexure No. 44.]

**SEARCH OF AN EXPORT FIRM IN BOMBAY**

THE MINISTER OF FINANCE (SHRI T. T. KRISHNAMACHARI): No search was made of the premises of M/s. G. Ram Chandra and Company, Bombay by the Customs, Central Excise, Gold Control or Enforcement Directorate authorities.

**COMPANIES PROSECUTED IN PUNJAB**

645. SHRI JAGAT NARAIN: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) the number of companies in Punjab prosecuted during the year 1963 and so far in 1964;

(b) the number of Directors of companies prosecuted and the number of those who are not traceable;

(c) the number of cases, out of the numbers mentioned in part (a) above, decided and the amount of fine collected; and

(cl) the total amount of expenditure incurred on the cases decided?

Difficulties have been experienced in Punjab in serving Court processes on directors of companies but no case was consigned by the Court to records on account of non-availability of accused directors during the aforesaid periods.
