THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI GULZARILAL NANDA): (a) 1,031 complaints were received through the Sanyukta Sadachar Samiti by the Ministry of Home Affairs upto 31st October, 1964.

(b) These complaints were mainly of the nature of delay, inequity, some other complaints of corruption and miscellaneous grievances and requests. They were generally forwarded to the Ministries, State Governments and Union Territories concerned for necessary action. Those on which no action was recommended by the Samiti were filed.

Will the Minister of REHABILITATION be pleased to state whether the Development Corps of new migrants has been engaged on any development projects?

THE MINISTER OF REHABILITATION (SHRI MAHAVIR TYAGI): Rashtriya Vikas Dat (National Development Corps) is in the process of being raised. The Scheme provides for a basic training of two months, followed by vocational training of two to four months in the case of those to be engaged on semi-skilled and skilled operations. The Sahkaris will be engaged on works after the completion of training.
