**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

SUBJECT:—Permission to Central Government servants for undertaking medical practice during their spare time—Grant of.

The Government of India have had under consideration the question of grant of permission to Central Government servants to practise medicine on purely charitable basis during their spare time. Since such practice of medicine by unqualified and untrained persons will be harmful to the community, it has been decided that permission to Central Government servants to undertake practice in any system of medicine should not be granted unless they hold recognised qualifications. Only per-

sons holding recognised qualifications in any system of medicine and registered under the relevant law in force in the State or Union Territory concerned, should be allowed to undertake medical practice. Heads of Departments may grant the required permission, provided the practice is undertaken during spare time, on purely charitable basis, without detriment to the official duties of the Government servant concerned.

2. Past cases, if any, in which permission has been granted to Government servants to undertake medical practice during their spare time, may be reviewed in the light of the above decision.

3. In so far as persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders issued in consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.
