

AND HEAVY ENGINEERING be pleased to state:

(a) what steps the Government of India has taken to persuade the State Governments not to proceed against the mine-owners for the arbitrary realisation of excess royalty, which is in contravention of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and ^Developments) Act, 1957; and

(b) the steps that have been taken for the speedy disposal of revision, petitions filed by the mine-owners with the Central Government?

THE MINISTER OF STEEL, MINES AND HEAVY ENGINEERING (SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM): (a) The difficulty has arisen only in Orissa. Pending a decision on the dispute between the State Government and some mine-owners regarding the manner of assessing royalty, the following relief has been given by the Central Government.

In regard to the royalty claimed by the State Government for the period ending December 1960, Government of India has granted the facility of payment of the dues claimed, in instalments. The State Government were also restrained from dispossessing the lessees by issue of stay orders.

Regarding the royalty claimed by the State Government for the period December, 1960 to December, 1962, the Central Government have been assured that the State Government are themselves considering grant of facility to pay in suitable instalments.

(b) As mentioned by m_c earlier in reply to Short Notice Question No. 25, dated the 6th May, 1964, two officers are being appointed to ensure speedy disposal of revision applications.. They are expected to join duty shortly.

HEAVY MACHINE BUILDING PLANT AND FOUNDRY FORGE PROJECT

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (SHRI M. C. CHAGLA): (a) According to the figures readily available (1960-61), the percentage of girls joining post-graduate studies in science was 12.6 (Physics 7.2 per cent., Chemistry 12.1 per cent., Botany 26.7 per cent., Geology 1.0 per cent., Zoology 29.8 per cent., and others science subjects 8.8 per cent.) and literature (languages) 33.5.

(b) In 1962-63, girl students constituted 18.9 per cent, of the total enrolment for Arts, Science and Commerce Courses in Universities and Colleges.
