THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI B. BHAGAVATI): (a) Yes Sir.

(b) Id-ul-Zuha is a regional holiday. Some P. & T. Circles observe it while others including Assam observe some other holiday in its place.

MILK PRICE IN DELHI

*70. { **SHRI DEOKINANDAN NARAYAN:**
 SHRI JAGAT NARAIN:

Will the Minister of **FOOD AND AGRICULTURE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that price of milk in Delhi went up by 50 per cent. during the month of May, 1964; and

(b) if so, what efforts are being made to check the rising price of milk in Delhi?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD AND AGRICULTURE (SHRI A. M. THOMAS): (a) Because of shortage of milk and increase in its demand, even in normal years its price goes up during summer. As the shortage is more acute this year, the rise in price has been greater than in other years. It is,

however, not known whether the price went up by 50 per cent.

(b) To increase supply of milk for liquid consumption, import of *khoa*, *paneer*, condensed milk and sweetmeats into Delhi was banned on 22nd May, 1964. This has enhanced the supply of milk.

(a) the names of the places in the Centrally administered areas where the per acre production of (i) rice; (ii) wheat; and (iii) sugarcane was the highest during the last three years; and

(b) the per acre yield obtained in respect of each of the items referred to in part (a) above?]

गेहूँ—दिल्ली ९४० पौंड

गन्ना (गुड़)—त्रिपुरा २,६८८ पौंड
