†[INTRODUCTION OF CORRESPONDENCE COURSES AND EVENING COLLEGES

12. SHRI B. N. BHARGAVA: Will the Minister of Education be pleased to refer to the reply given to Starred Question No. 295 on 7th March, 1963 in Rajya Sabha and state:

(a) the names of places where the scheme of correspondence courses and evening colleges was started during the year 1963-64 and the names of places where it is likely to be started in the year 1964-65; and

(b) whether M.A. Examination has also been included in the correspondence courses?]

In 1964-65 also there is no proposal to start Correspondence Courses anywhere. But a scheme of grant-in-aid to Evening Colleges has been sent to all State Governments and universities; and proposals are awaited.
