CHINESE COMMUNISTS' CONSPIRACY TO ASSASSINATE MAHARAJA OF SLKKIM

- 101. SHRI A. B. VAJPAYEE: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to an interview given by the Maharaja of Sikkim to the effect that the Chinese Commu-niits were conspiring to assassinate him; and
- (b) if so, whether any security measures have been taken by the Government of India t₀ avert any untoward incident?

THE PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI GVLZAKX LAL NANDA): (a) The Government of India has seen the press report about an interview given by the Maharaja of Sikkim to a correspondent of the Hindustan Samachar when the Maharaja was reported to have referred to a Chinese plot to take his life. On the 15th Mav. the S'kkim Darbar formally contradicted

to Questions this press report and said that no such interview had been given by the Maharaja.

- (c) whether the Prime Minister agreed to place the formula before the Prime Minister of China: and
- (d) what are the details of the formula?

THE PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI GULZARI LAL NANDA): (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) On page 255 of the book entitled "Krishna Menon" written by T. J. S. George, under the caption entitled "The End of the Road", the author conveyn the impression that Shri Krishna Menon suggested a formula to lease to China, Aksai Chin in return for a narrow strip oi Chinese territory between Sikkim and Bhutan.
- (c) Government have no knowledge of any such formula having been suggested. Thece is, therefore, no question of our Prime Minister having agreed to place this formula before the Prime Minister of China.
