THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (SHRI M. C. CHAGLA): (a) and (b) — The requisite information is not readily available.

#### **LANGUAGE TEACHERS IN DELHI SCHOOLS**

829. SHRI ABDUL GHANI: Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a language teacher is provided in a school if there are 12 students either in class VI or in IX whose parents permit their wards in writing to offer any one of the Modern Indian Languages; and

(b) if so, how many students are required in higher secondary classes for which a post-graduate teacher is provided?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (SHRI M. C. CHAGLA): (a). Yes, Madam. Arrangements for the teaching of a particular language to the students of Class VI or IX are made within the sanctioned strength of teachers of the number of students of that language is at least 12. A separate language teacher is provided when the teaching periods in that language range from 30 to 36 per week.

(b) A post graduate language teacher is provided for Class XI only, and the number of students in that class should be at least 12.
