#### EXPORT OF RICE FROM MADHYA PRADESH

33. SHRI K. C. BAGHEL: Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) how much rice has been exported from Madhya Pradesh to each of the other States since January, 1964; and

(b) how much rice was exported to (i) Maharashtra and (ii) Gujarat after the export from Madhya Pradesh was banned by the Government of Madhya Pradesh?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD AND AGRICULTURE (SHRI D. R. CHAVAN): (a) The following quantities of rice were exported from Madhya Pradesh to other States during the period 1st January to 28th August, 1964:—

(b) Export of rice from Madhya Pradesh was not banned by the State Government. They only introduced a system of regulated exports under permits issued for the purpose. This system was introduced from 8th March, 1964. The following quantities of rice have moved from Madhya Pradesh to Maharashtra and Gujarat between 8th March and 28th August, 1964.
