THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD AND AGRICULTURE (SHRI D. R. CHAVAN): Yes, Sir. Apart from U.S.A. from where rice is imported under PL-480 Agreement, varying quantities of rice were offered by Burma, Cambodia and Thailand for purchase against foreign exchange and by Pakistan against barter. Purchase contracts for 70,000 tons from Pakistan under a barter arrangement and 10,000 tons from Thailand have since been concluded. It is proposed to purchase 10,000 tons from Cambodia very shortly.

TUBEWELL EXPLORATION IN MYSORE STATE
