cases 13 granted by the Education Minister, the Prime Minister agreed as a special case, to give some additional help to Shri Muktibodh's family out of the funds at his disposal on the request of a deputation of Hindi writers and poets.

TEEN MURTI HOUSE

- 50. SHRI A. D. MANX: Will the PRIME MINISTER be peased to state:
- (a) whether Government have decided to use Teen Murti House as a i memorial to the late Prime Minister Shri Jawaharlal Nehru; and
- (b) if so, what kind of memorial is proposed to be set up in the building?

THE PRIME MINISTER (SHRI LAL BAHADUR): (a) and (b) Government have decided that the Teen Murti House should be used primarily for a Museum, with' a Library, dedicated to the memory of Jawaharlalji. The Ministry of Education would implement these proposals regarding the Museum and Library as a Government project. The Southern Wing of the House would be utilised for the proposed Personalia Museum. The Northern Wing would be "sed for housing the proposed Library; some of the smaller rooms in the Northern Wing might be used for putting up visiting research scholars and lecturers. The middle portion, consisting of the large lounge in the ground floor and the large public rooms on the first floor, would also be put to other uses in keeping with the above-mentioned purposes.

SENIORITY OF MEMBERS OF POSTS AND TELEGRAPHS BOARD

- 51. Shri M. P. BHARGAVA: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to refer to the answer given to Unstarred Ouestion No. 44 in the Raiva Sabha on the 1st Juie, 1964 and state:

and Telegraphs Board against superseding their seniority have since been disposed

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNICA-TIONS (SHRI B. BHAGAVATI): (a) and (b) The matter is still under con. sideration in consultation with tht Union Public Service Commission and the Ministry of Home Affairs.

DELIVERY OF EXPRESS LETTERS

- 52. SHRI M. P. BHARGAVA: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to refer to the answer given to Unstarred Question No. 2d in the Rajya Sabha on the 1st June 1964 and state:
- (a) whether any improvement in the service of express delivery articles has since been noticed; and
- (b) whether any letters of complaints against, or in appreciation of the new arrangement have been received?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNICA-TIONS (SHRI B. BHAGAVATI): (a> Yes. The number of complaint" about E.D. articles has shown * decrease from about one for every 4,000 articles handled in 1962-63 ti about one for 5.000 in 1963-64.
