SITUATION IN VIETNAM

42. SHRI U. S. DUGAL: Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state what steps Government propose to take to prevent spread of hostilities in the Vietnam area?

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SARDAR SWARAN SINGH): The Government of India firmly support the Geneva Agreement of 1954 on Vietnam, which envisages the

peaceful reunification of that country. India's representative on the International Commission in Vietnam will continue to perform his duties as laid down in the Agreement and endeavour to work for a peaceful reunification of Vietnam.

M.P.s' DELEGATION TO FORMOSA

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a delegation of M.Ps. recently visited Formosa, Korea and other countries; and

(b) if so, who bore the expenses of the delegation?

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SARDAR SWARAN SINGH): (a) A delegation consisting, amongst others, of eight Members of Parliament visited Taiwan, Korea and other countries in their private capacities.

(b) It is understood that a private organisation, Asian People's Anti-Communist League, bore the expenses for the visits.

#### RADIO STATIONS IN INDIA

44. SHRI S. K. VAISHAMPAYEN: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state

(a) the number of Principal Radio Stations and Relay Centres in each State as on the 31st March, 1964

(b) the names of places where they are located and the capacity of each of them;

(c) the minimum and maximum distance between any two radio

stations now operating in the country; and

(d) the criteria on which a radio station is considered for installation in a particular locality or area?

THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRIMATI INDIRA GANDHI): (a) and (b) A list indicating the total number of principal Radio Stations and Relay Centres Statewise as on 31st March 1964 is laid on the Table of the House. It is not in the public interest to disclose details of their capacity (presumably power).

(c) Minimum distance between any two radio stations is 96 k.m. and the maximum distance 325 k.m.

(d) The Radio Stations are generally located at cultural and linguistic centres of the respective regions to ensure effective utilisation of talent and high standard of programmes. The locations are also guided by requirements of the broadcast coverage and other special characteristics of the area. Distance between Stations is not the only deciding factor in the selection of a particular location.
