THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE PRODUCTION IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI A. M. THOMAS?): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) and (c) The matter is actively being pursued by the Government.

#### 14-NATION CONFERENCE ON LAOS

\*60. SHRI JAGAT NARAIN: Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) how far India has been successful in the convening of a 14-Nation Conference on Laos; and

(b) whether Government have received any reply from any of the participating nations to the Geneva Pact of 1954?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS-(SHRI DINESH SINGH): (a) The Government of India have fully supported a proposal recently made by the Government of Union of Soviet Socialist Republic for the convening of a 14-Nation Geneva Conference on Laos. However, Government recog—

nise that, ultimately, it is for the three parties to resolve their differences. The leaders of the three parties are now in Paris and it is hoped that their talks will lead to an agreement which will pave the way for a 14-Nation Conference on Laos.

(b) Government of India are in touch with a number of other Governments on this question. However, the question of getting any specific replies from the countries which participated in the Geneva Conference on Laos in 1962 does not arise.

The figures relating to the extent of sale, are being collected and will be laid on the table of the Sabha as soon as these become available.
