TRAINING UNDER THE NATIONAL DISCIPLINE SCHEME

293. SHRIMATI DEVAKI GOPIDAS: Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) on what principles selection for training under the National Discipline Scheme is made from the States;

(b) whether any quota is fixed for each State;

(c) on what basis selection from Kerala was made in the month of June, 1964;

(d) whether he is aware that various Employment Exchanges in the States were not informed to send their candidates; and

(e) whether Government propose to make arrangements to give chances to the candidates from Employment Exchanges that were not represented in the last selection?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SHRI BHAKT DARSHAN) : (a) The selection is made in accordance with the provisions contained in the approved recruitment rules prescribed for the

respective posts under the National Discipline Scheme.

(b) No quota is fixed for each State, but the allocation of seats is made keeping in view the requirements of the States and the total number of vacancies for a particular course.

(c) to (e) The information is being collected from the concerned Regional office of the National Discipline Scheme and a statement will be laid on the Table of the House in due course.

TRANSIT/WORK CAMPS FOR DISPLACED PERSONS FROM EAST PAKISTAN

294. SHRI K. C. BAGHEL: Will the Minister of REHABILITATION be pleased to state:

(a) how many displaced persons from East Pakistan have been sent to Transit Camps in Mana Kurud, Nava-gaon and Manipuri near Raipur City in Madhya Pradesh;

(b) how many of them have been sent to Work Camps;

(c) the places of their location and the number of displaced persons in each of these camps;

(d) how many of these displaced persons died of Gastro-Enteritis; and

(e) how many persons have been arrested for inciting others not to work in Transit/Work Camps?

THE MINISTER OF REHABILITATION (SHRI MAHAVIR TYAGI): (a) 1,72,136 persons up to 7th September, 1964.

(b) 81,444 persons admitted to the Mana group of camps have been sent to camps in different States according to information received till the 9th September.

(c) A statement is appended.

(d) and (e) Information is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the House.
