#### CASES OF CORRUPTION

290. SHRI J. H. JOSHI: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of cases of corruption which were detected by Government during the period from March to August, 1964; and

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI JAISUKHLAL HATHI): (a) The Special Police Establishment Division of the Central Bureau of Investigation have taken up 991 such cases during the period from March to August 1964.

(b) The number of such cases taken up by the S.P.E. Division of the Central Bureau of Investigation during the period from March to August 1963 was 779.

#### EXPANSION OF O.N.G.C.

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS (SHRI HUMAYUN KABIR): Dr. D. N. Wadia, a well-known Geologist, has been appointed as a Member (part-time) of the Oil and Natural Gas Commission with effect from the 27th July, 1964, and we are considering the appointment of one or two more members with specialised knowledge.

#### TRAINING UNDER THE NATIONAL DISCIPLINE SCHEME

293. SHRIMATI DEVAKI GOPIDAS: Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) on what principles selection for training under the National Discipline Scheme is made from the States;

(b) whether any quota is fixed for each State;

(c) on what basis selection from Kerala was made in the month of June, 1964;

(d) whether he is aware that various Employment Exchanges in the States were not informed to send their candidates; and

(e) whether Government propose to make arrangements to give chances to the candidates from Employment Exchanges that were not represented in the last selection?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SHRI BHAKT DARSHAN) : (a) The selection is made in accordance with the provisions contained in the approved recruitment rules prescribed for the

respective posts under the National Discipline Scheme.

(b) No quota is fixed for each State, but the allocation of seats is made keeping in view the requirements of the States and the total number of vacancies for a particular course.

(c) to (e) The information is being collected from the concerned Regional office of the National Discipline Scheme and a statement will be laid on the Table of the House in due course.
