*439. SHRI THANGA TAMIL SELVAN: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of Navodaya Vidyalayas in the country, State-wise;
- (b) the amount spent on these Vidyalayas annually on recurring basis;
- (c) the amount spent on setting up of one Navodaya Vidyalaya; and
- (d) whether Government would consider setting up of Navodaya Vidyalaya in Tamil Nadu without Hindi as a subject?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI MD. ALI ASHRAF FATMI): (a) The number of functional Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas (JNVs) State-wise is given in the Statement. (See below)

(b) The operational expenditure incurred on recurring basis on Navodaya Vidyalayas during 2003-04 and 2004-05 was Rs. 364.49 crore and Rs. 410.54 crore, respectively.

(c) The amount spent on setting up a JNV upto class XII (with a student strength of 560) is as under:—

(i) Non-recurring expenditure:

(a) Construction of school building - Rs. 8.5 crore

(b) Equipment - Rs. 90 lakhs.

(ii) Recurring expenditure:

(a) Staff salaries - Rs. 85 lakh per annum

(b) Other recurring cost - Rs. 30 lakh per annum
