† THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI DINESH SINGH): (a) According to the information available with our Embassy in Rangoon, the number Indian nationals arrested and detained in Burma in 1962-63 and 1963-64 were 11 and 24, respectively. In addition, a number of people of Indian origin, whose nationality status could not be clearly established, were also arrested and detained during this period. No official information of such arestes and detentions had been received by our Embassy.

(b) They were arested for infiringement of Burma Immigration and Foreigners Regulations, smuggling. violation of Foreign Exchange Regulations, money lending and on other unspecified charges.

(c) Our Embassy in Rangoon took up cach case with the Burmese Government. Replies to our representations are still awaited.]

- (c) The Government of India deeply regret the Indonesian Government's decision to associate themselves with an unfair and one-sided view on the Kashmir question.

solved peacefully and might even constitute a threat to peace and stability in the region. † [THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND EM-PLOYMENT AND NING (SHRI C R. PATTABHI RAMAN): (a) and (b) The State Governments have been requested to revise upward the minimum rates of ages for those scheduled employments under Minimum Wages Act where they have been intially fixed at less than Re. 1 per day, so that in no case minimum wage rate under the Act for any scheduled employment be less than Re. 1 per day.

Under the present conditions, a wage rate lower than Re. 1 per day cannot but be considered too low. While requesting the State Governments to revise the wage rate to bring it at least at Re. 1 per day, the intention was not to peg down the wage rates upwards, wherever they are day, but to revise the minimum wage rates upwards, wherever they are found to be too low.]

INDIANS KILLED IN GEORGETOWN
