ANNOUNCEMENT RE CONVICTION OF SHRI R. GOPALAKRISHNAN, M.P.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: I have to inform Members that I have received the following communication dated the 8th February, 1964, from the Sessions Judge, South Arcot District, Cuddalore:

"I have the honour to inform you that Shri R. Gopalakrishnan, son of Ramasami Mazhavaroyar, Member of the Rajya Sabha (residing at No. 79, 5th Cross Road, Kanakasabainagar, Chidambaram in South Arcot District of the Madras State) was tried at the court of Session, before me in Sessions case No. 87 of 63 as 1st accused on a charge of criminal conspiracy to murder one Dhanapal, punishable under section 120-B read with section 302—I.P.C.

Today, i.e. 8th February, 1964 the trial lasting for 18 days, I found him guilty of the offence punishable under section 120-B read with section 302 I.P.C. and sentenced him to imprisonment for life.

He is today committed to the Central Jail, Vellore (North Arcot District) to undergo the sentence of imprisonment for life."
