THENGARI: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state;</p>	

(a) whether it is a fact that a large number of Government employees who own houses in Delhi and have let out some portions on profitable rents, are being paid house rent allowance;

(b) if so, the number of such Government employees and the monthly amount of house rent allowance paid to them; and

(c) what is the reason for paying house rent allowance to such employees?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHHIMATI TARKESHWARI SINHA): (a) and (c) No house rent allowance is paid to Government employees for the portions of their own houses which are let out by them on rent. Like employees living in , rented premises, those living in their own houses are also eligible to draw house rent allowance. The amount of the allowance, is in each case based on the Municipal rental value, of the accommodation actually occupied by them subject to that accommodation being within sanctioned limits.

(b) There has been no occasion to collect such information. The labour Involved in collecting the information will not be commensurate with the value of the results.

#### IMPACT OF DEVELOPMENT PLANS ON PEOPLE

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT AND FOR PLANNING (SHRI C. R. PATTABHI RAMAN): (a) Yes, Sir. The objective of this study is to attempt evaluative analysis of differences in levels of consumption and living, improvements in agriculture, rural industries and similar fields among different regions and population groups in each State and, as far as possible, understand changes that have taken place in the recent past.

(b) As the study is still in the preparatory stage, it is too early to expect any reports from the State Governments.
