- (a) whether it is a fact that the higher grade of coal in the Jharia coalfield area is found at a higher level than the low grade coal; and
 - (b) if so, the reason therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STEEL, MINES AND HEAVY ENGINEERING (SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) This is due to the typical geological formation of that coalfield.

- (c) Officers can elect to draw their grade pay plus a special pay (Rs. 200/-in case of Under Secretary and Rs. 300/- in case of Deputy Secretary) or pay in the scale of the post, viz., Rs. 900—1250, for Under Secretary and Rs. 1100—1800 in the case of Deputy Secretary.
 - (d) Nil.

FERTILIZER AND BYE-PRODUCTS PRODUCED AT BHILAI STEEL PLANT

- *345. SHRI DAYALDAS KURRE: Will the Minister of STEEL, MINES AND HEAVY ENGINEERING be pleased to state:
- (a) whether the Bhilai Steel Preject is producing fertilizers; and
- (b) what are the other byeproducts which are being produced at the plant?

THE MINISTER OF STEEL, MINES AND HEAVY ENGINEERING (SHAR C. SUBRAMANIAM): (a) Yes, Sir. Ammonium sulphate, a fertilizer, is produced as a bye-product of the Coke Oven and Bye-Product Plant.

(b) During the process of carbonisation of coal certain bye-products such as crude tar, light crude benzol, pure benzene, pitch, naphthalene, xylene,
