

फिफ्त आर्मी (गणतन्त्र राज्य चीन) का कार्यालय था। इसके बाद वह फ्लैट कई विभिन्न किरायेदारों के कब्जे में रहा, परन्तु बिजली का मीटर सितम्बर, १९६३ तक चाईनीज फिफ्थ आर्मी के नाम में चलता रहा, क्योंकि बाद के किसी किरायेदार ने मीटर का रजिस्ट्रेशन अपने नाम में बदलवाने का कष्ट नहीं किया, यद्यपि वे उस फ्लैट की बिजली के बिल अदा करते रहे।

३. विदेशी मुद्रा से सम्बन्धित अभियोग के एक मामले की जांच के लिये कलकत्ता पुलिस ने जब इस फ्लैट की तलाशी ली, तो चाईनीज फिफ्थ आर्मी के नाम में बिजली के बिलों की रसीदें वहाँ पर मिलीं। चाईनीज फिफ्थ आर्मी के नाम के बिलों से चीनी पंचांगीय सेवा के होने का भ्रम हो गया, तथा इस के परिणामस्वरूप बिना जांच किये ही रिपोर्ट प्रकाशित कर दी गई।

STATEMENT

The Editor[†] which appeared in "The Observer" dated the 15th November, 1963 was apparently based on a news item which appeared in the issue of "The Hindustan Times" dated the 7th November, 1963. The news report is not factually correct.

2. Flat No. 25 of Premises No. 34, Ganesh Chander Avenue referred to in the newspaper report was used as an office of the Chinese 5th Army (Republic of China) from 1st October, 1942 to 31st January, 1946, during the last World War. Thereafter, the flat changed many hands but the electricity meter continued to be in the name of the Chinese 5th Army till September, 1963 as none of the subsequent tenants took the trouble of

getting the registration of the meter changed in their name though they went on paying the charges on account of the electricity bills for the flat which they were occupying.

3. The receipts of these electricity bills in the name of the Chinese 5th Army were found in this flat when the Calcutta Police conducted a search in connection with a case of alleged foreign exchange racket. Electricity Bills in the name of Chinese 5th Army must have created a false impression about the existence of Chinese fifth column army and led to an unverified report being published.]

THEFT OF CABS IN DELHI
