178. SHRI B. N. BHARGAVA: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state whether Government propose to set up a radio station in Bundelkhand in the State of Uttar Pradesh during either the Third or the Fourth Five Year Plan period?]

संसद्-कार्य मंत्री (श्री सत्य नारायण सिंह) : तीसरी पंचवर्षीय योजना काल में बुन्देलखण्ड में रेडियो स्टेशन स्थापित करने की कोई योजना नहीं है। लखनऊ में लगे हुए १० किलोवाट शॉर्टवेव और ५० किलोवाट मीडियमवेव ट्रांसमीटर से इस क्षेत्र के लिए प्रसारण होता है। चौथी पंचवर्षीय योजना के लिए प्रस्ताव अभी तैयार किए जाने हैं।

[THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI SATYA NARAYAN SINHA) : There is no proposal to set up a Radio Station in Bundelkhand during the Third Five Year Plan. This area is served by the existing 10 kw shortwave and 50 kw medium wave transmitters at Lucknow. The proposals for the Fourth Five Year Plan are yet to be formulated].

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE PRODUCTION IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI K. RAGHU RAMAIAH) : (a) to (c) A company with Read-quarters in New Delhi has been* registered for the manufacture of aeroengines at Koraput in Orissa, airframes at Nasik in Maharashtra and electronic components at Hyderabad in Andhra Pradesh. The details are under preparation.
