

**GLOBAL TENDERS FOR BOKARO STEEL PLANT**

**230. SHRI SITARAM JAIPURIA:** Will the Minister of STEEL, MINES AND HEAVY ENGINEERING be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have invited global tenders for supplying machinery and equipment for the Bokaro Steel Plant;

(b) if so, from which countries tenders have been received; and

(c) whether orders have been placed for any machinery?

**THE MINISTER OF STEEL, MINES AND HEAVY ENGINEERING (SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM):** (a) No, Sir.

(b) and (c) Do not arise. The position, however, is that Government have appointed a Technical Committee to examine the Project Report submitted by M/s. Dasturco. The examination of the project report is expected to be completed before the end of December, 1963. Thereafter the work of preparing specifications of plant and equipment required for the project has to be taken in hand. It is only after specifications are ready that we can tender.

(a) whether some persons were recently arrested in Delhi on the charge of forging import licences; and
