

Governments for Central help to repatriate beggars coming from other States; and

(b) if so, what are the details of these proposals?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRIMATI MARAGATHAM CHANDRA-SEKHAR): (a) A proposal received from the Government of Maharashtra is under consideration.

(b) It has been suggested that the beggars apprehended in Bombay and coming from States other than Maharashtra may be repatriated to the States of their origin, or those States may be requested to bear the expenditure on their rehabilitation. Alternatively, the Government of India may reimburse this expenditure.
