So far 3 lathes and 22 Milling machines have been exported, earning in all a foreign exchange of Rs. 8,85,180. One lathe has been exported to each of the countries West Germany. Switzerland and Nepal. Besides this, orders for the export of 9 lathes and 1 milling machine have heen booked.

## STATEMENT

The capacity of the Heavy Electricals Plant, Bhopal, in its present stage of development, including construction and equipping, is for achieving an annual output of Rs. 12.5 crores; as against this, the factory registered an output of Rs. 3.3 crores. including works in progress, during 1962-63, covering the manufacture of transformers, switchgear, control gear, capacitors and traction equipment. With the completion of the construction and equipping of the main Factory Blocks I and II for the manufacture of turbines, generators and industrial motors and the progressive development of production techniques and skills of the workers with a view to reach optimum levels of production in each line of manufacture, it is proposed to utilise the capacity of the plant fully, as early as possible.
