SHRI KOTA PUNNAIAH: May I know
 whether it is a fact that more than Rs. 4000
 are due to the Government of India towards
 water, electricity and rent charges, but due to
 false accounts and misappropriation of funds
 the Store has been shown as running at a loss?
 If so, what steps have been taken to recover
 its dues and safeguard the interests of the
 members of the store?

SHRI S. D. MISRA: I have got the balances
 as on 30th June, 1958. This is the information
 I can give because I have told the hon.
 Members of this House that for the last five
 years the accounts have not been audited.
 From that I find that the total assets were
 about Rs. 5450, and the total liabilities were
 about Rs. 12,000. On that day the Store had a
 loss of Rs. 6,939. Besides that I cannot say
 anything more. It has to be looked into.

**CONFERENCE OF HEADS OF P. & T.
CIRCLES**

•471. SHRI S. C. DEB: Will the Minister of LAW be pleased to state:

(a) what are the decisions arrived at the conference of Heads of Posts and Telegraphs Circles recently held in New Delhi; and

(b) whether any decision was taken regarding housing problems, specially of Class HI and Class IV employees, of the departments and delay in delivery of express letters?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF POSTS AND TELEGRAPHS (SHRI B. BHAGAVATI) : (a) The Conference is usually called annually to discuss and exchange views on the pressing problems of the Department, and the Conference held early last month discussed many such problems. Being a consultative organisation, it could not take final decisions. Its recommendations will be referred to the P. & T. Board for decision.

(b) Expansion of the building activity of the Department and improvement of the express delivery service were among the important subjects discussed at the recent Conference. As already stated, the recommendations of the Conference
