Shri KOTA PUNNAIAH: May I know whether it is a fact that more than Rs. 4000 are due to the Government of India towards water, electricity and rent charges, but due to false accounts and misappropriation of funds the Store has been shown as running at a loss? If so, what steps have been taken to recover its dues and safeguard the interests of the members of the store?

SHRI S. D. MISRA: I have got the balances as on 30th June, 1958. This is the information I can give because I have told the hon. Members of this House that for the last five years the accounts have not been audited. From that I find that the total assets were about Rs. 5450, and the total liabilities were about Rs. 12,000. On that day the Store had a loss of Rs. 6,939. Besides that I cannot say anything more. It has to be looked into.
