GRANTS-IN-AID TO PHIMIRY AIDED SCHOOLS IN DELHI

THE MINISTER OF SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS (SHRI HUMAYUN KABIR): (a) and (b) There has been delay in the payment of grants-in-aid for the 2nd quarter of the year to some private primary schools aided by the Delhi Municipal Corporation. The delay is reported to be due to a change in the accounting procedure of the Municipal Corporation and is being looked into. The names of the 25 schools to which the grants-in-aid for the second quarter have not yet been released, are given below:
