CARS STOLEN IN DELNI

- 4. SHRI BANSI LAL: Will the Minister of Home Affairs be pleased to state:
- (a) the number of cars which were stolen in Delhi during the period from January to July, 1963 and what were the makes of those cars;
- (b) how many of these cars were recovered and what were the results of cases filed against the persons apprehended for these crimes; and
- (c) what steps Government are taking to check the menace of car thefts in the Capital?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI R. M. HAJARNAVIS):

- (b) 28.9 cases were sent up trial. In one case the accused has been convicted. The remaining cases are pending trial.
- (c) Constant vigilance is maintained by the Police to check this menance in Delhi. A special squad consisting of 1 Inspector, 2 sub-Inspectors, 1 Assistant Sub-Inspector, 1 Head Constable and 8 Constables, has been set up to investigate all theft motor cars in Delhi.

MINERALS FOUND IN TRIPURA

- (a) what minerals have been found in Tripura as a result of the geological survey conducted so far;

THE MINISTER OF MINES FUEL (SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN): (a) Lignite, gas seepages and clays have so far been recorded. Possible oil and gas bearing structures have also been found at some places.

(b) and (c) The occurrences so far recorded are not of economic importance.

BENGALI VERSION OF HINDI TEXT BOOKS

6. SHRI P. C. MITRA: Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state the arrangements that have so far been made for the publication of Bengali version of Hind, Text Books for primary classes in Delhi schools on subjects (other than languages) including Arithmetic, Social Study and Home Science?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (Dr. K. L. SHRIMALI): The Twelve approved Hindi Text Books Arithmetic. General Science/Home Science, Social Studies and Geometry have been translated into Bengali and efforts are now being made to get them printed through the publishers who own copyright of the original books in Hindi.
