THERMAL POWER STATION NEAR MUGMA COAL-BELT

- *53. SHRI SURJIT SINGH ATWAL: Will the Minister of IRRIGATION AND POWER be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that the Damodar Valley Corporation have forwarded to Government a proposal for putting up a 2000 MW capacity Thermal Power Station near the coal-belt of Mugma in the District of Dhanbad, Bihar State; and

THE MINISTER OF IRRIGATION AND POWER (DR. K. L. RAO): (a) No, Sir. The D.V.C. have, however, submitted a proposal to set up, during the IV Plan period, a Thermal Power Station consisting of two units of

125/140 MW near the Maithon reser-

voir, which is not very far from the Mugma coal belt.

(b) Government will take a decision on this matter after taking into consideration all other power plans formulated in respect of various parts of the Region for implementation during the IV Plan period.
