

THE MINISTER OF MINES AND FUEL (SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN): (a) and (b) The Government of Poland has extended two credits to the Government of India for the development of various industrial projects. Under the first credit dated the 7th May, 1960, are included two mines viz. Sudamdih and Monidih which are being developed by the N.C.D.C. in Jharia coalfields in Bihar. The second credit of the 16th November, 1962, includes the development of seven deep mines, out of which the N.C.D.C. will develop three mines in Jharia coalfields in Bihar and two in the Santa coalfields in West Bengal. Provisionally, one deep mine each has been allocated to the Government of West Bengal and the Singareni Collieries Company, Andhra Pradesh.
