RAW MATERIALS FOR SMALL SCALE INDUSTRY

173. SHRI KRISHNA CHANDRA: Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state what is the State-wise break-up of various raw materials and component parts allocated for small-scale industries for the current year?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (SHRI N. KANUNGO): Component parts are not allocated State-wise. A statement giving allocation of non-ferrous metals, polystyrene and steel which are allocated State-wise is attached. [See Appendix XLII, Annexure No. 1.]

(b) if so, what action has so far been taken by the State Governments to implement the said recommendations?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (SHRI N. KANUNGO): (a) Yes Sir.

RECRUITMENT RULES FOR POSTS IN DANDAKARANYA PROJECT

Rules for recruitment to non-gazetted posts are under preparation. These rules will be examined in the Ministry and notified in the Gazette as soon as possible.
