(b) whether the number of such cases, as compared to the previous years, is on the decline; and

(c) if not, why not?

#### 28 GAUGE M.S. BLACK SHEETS

\*383. SHRI M. M. SUR: Will the Minister of STEEL AND HEAVY INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

(a) whether 28 gauge M.S. Black Sheets are being rolled at the Rourkela Steel Plant; and

(b) if so, by when 28 and 30 gauges M.S. Black Sheets will be available for small and medium sized processing industries?

THE MINISTER OF STEEL AND HEAVY INDUSTRIES (SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. Since January, 1962 Rourkela Plant has been despatching Black Sheets of thinner gauges to allottees on the basis of planning done by the Iron and Steel Controller.
