**Traffic patterns for planned Urban Development**

3534. SHRIMATI SHOBHANA BHARTIA: Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state

(a) whether in a bid to predict traffic patterns for planned urban development, Government are setting up a National Urban Transport Information Centre to serve as traffic, emission, ridership and travel behaviour;

(b) if so, whether data centres would help policy-makers and implementation agencies to determine the feasibility of the project being undertaken;

(c) whether this move has assumed significance in backdrop of the recent budget announcement on having metro system in Hyderabad, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat; and

(d) if so, by when a final decision in this regard is likely to be taken?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI AJAY MAKEN): (a) to (d) A National Urban Transport Information Centre has been set up to compile, collate and disseminate data that would be relevant for urban transport planning in general. It would help in developing appropriate policies and plans and also in making relevant investment decisions. There is no direct connection with any specific project and it is intended to benefit decision making on proposals for investments in urban transport systems in general.
