

**Completion of Mysore-Bangalore Highway**

3596. SHRI JESUDASU SEELAM: Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether clearance has been given by the Supreme Court to go ahead with the construction of 110 Km. long Mysore-Bangalore 2200 crore rupees corridor project which was dumped in the cold storage for several years; if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether any target has been fixed for the completion of this dream project of Karnataka; and

(c) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIAPPA): (a) to (c) The Ministry of Shipping, Road Transport and Highways is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways. Mysore-Bangalore Highway is a State road and falls within the purview of State Government of Karnataka.

MUNIAPPA): (a) to (c) The State Government of Gujarat during 2004-05 and 2005-06 has forwarded proposals for declaration of 19 State roads and National Highways. The list is enclosed as per Statement (See below). At present, emphasis is being given on development of roads already declared as

National Highways instead of declaring more roads as National Highways. Therefore, during this period no State road of Gujarat has been declared as a National Highway.
