CHINESE PRISONERS OF WAR

- 133. SHRI M. P. BHARGAVA: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:
- (a) whether any Chinese taken as prisoners of war during October-November, 1962;
- (b) whether any cases of impersonation by Chinese as members of the Indian defence personnel or Indian officers were detected during October -November, 1962; and
- (c) if so, how these cases were dealt with?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI D. R. CHAVAN): (a) No, Sir.

(b) It is not possible to verify if Chinese committed impersonation during the operations of October-November, 1962. However, in certain sectors in NEFA, Chinese troops dressed in uniform resembling ours were seen by our troops from a distance.

(c) Does not, ariae in vie* ott raply to (b).

Stara M. P. BHARGAVA: May 1 know whether Government came ac-rosa any cases of impersonation by tha Chinese?

SHRI D. R. CHAVAN: It has already been answered, Sir. They were geen from a distance only.

SHRI M. P. BHARGAVA: May I know whether any Chinese impersonated as Indian defence personnel and were caught by the Indian defence 'forces?

SHRI Y. B. CHAVAN: WeU, Sir. There is a very isolated single case which took place in Darjeeling. That is about one person who happens to be the son of a Chinese through an Indian woman who was recruited as an Indian Gurkha, and he was spotted out and was placed under arrest.
