Chinese intention to explode an atom bomb in the Gobi Desert; and

(b) if so, whether Government have asked for information from experts about Kashmir being affected by the fall-out of any explosion in the Gobi Desert?

THE PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI JAWAHARLAL NEHRU) : (a) Government are aware of reports regarding the possibility of the Chinese holding nuclear tests but these reports are so far unconfirmed.

(b) Periodical examinations are undertaken of air, water and soil samples from various parts of India, including Kashmir, to find out if there is any increase in the radiation content. The latest examinations have not revealed anything abnormal.

ATTACK BY ELEPHANT ON AN ARMY TRUCK IN NEFA

(a) whether it is a fact that an army truck was recently attacked by an elephant on Kimi-Zero Road in the Subansiri Division of NEFA killing nine occupants of the truck;

(b) whether in another jeep accident near Bomdila, three army personnel, including a major, were killed and two other seriously injured on 5th February, 1963; and

(c) if so, how these accidents happened and what action Government axe taking to avert such accidents?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI Y. B. CHAVAN) : (a) No such accident has been reported.

(b) Yes.

(c) The cause of the jeep accident is being investigated by a Court of Inquiry. Further action, if necessary, will be taken after the findings of the Court of Inquiry are available.
