(b) his early departure does not entail a corresponding early transfer from another station of a Government servant to perform his duties; and

(c) the delay in his return does not involve a corresponding delay in the transfer to another station of the Government servant who was performing his duties during his absence or in the discharge from Government service of a person temporarily appointed to it.

S.R. 211.—Unless the competent authority in any case otherwise direct—

(a) If holidays are prefixed to leave, the leave and any consequent rearrangement of pay and allowances takes effect from the first day after the holidays, and

(b) if holidays are affixed to leave or joining time, the leave or joining time is treated as having terminated on, and any consequent rearrangement of pay and allowances takes effect from the day on which the leave or joining time would have ended if holidays had not been affixed.

ADDITIONAL INCREMENTS TO DELHI UNIVERSITY LECTURERS

•338. **SHRI PURNA CHANDRA SHARMA:** Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether the University Grants Commission has recently issued a circular to the Delhi University and its colleges to the effect that two additional increments which were given to the lecturers who have done Ph.D. should be stopped in future;

(c) whether Government are aware that there is resentment among the lecturers who are doing research work; and

(d) whether Government propose to revive the practice of giving these increments?

COAL ALLOTTED TO THE DELHI STATE CENTRAL COOPERATIVE STORES LIMITED

•341. **MIRZA AHMED ALL** Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that at the time of checking by the Civil Supplies Department, Delhi in September/October 1961, much lesser reserve stock was found than shown in the books of the Delhi State Central Cooperative Stores Limited, as well as in the endorsement register of the Civil Supplies Office;

(b) whether it is a fact that the Delhi State Central Cooperative Stores Limited received 296 wagons of steam coal, 128 wagons of hard coke, 1826 wagons of soft coke and 150 wagons of slack coal from February 1961 to September 1961; if not, what are the correct figures; and

(c) whether it is a fact that they allotted only 100 wagons of steam

coal and hard coke against a total arrival of 424 wagons and sold 324 unallotted surplus wagons in black market at a huge profit besides rebate on steam, hard, slack and soft coke which is not entered in any of their books?

THE MINISTER or STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI B. N. DATAR): (a) The stock of coal declared by the Delhi State Central Cooperative Stores Ltd. as having been kept in reserve was found to be less on checking. The endorsement register maintained by the Civil Supplies Department does not record information about reserve stocks.

(b) The Delhi State Central Cooperative Stores Limited received 295 wagons of steam coal, 120 wagons of hard coke, 1628 wagons of soft coke and 217 wagons of slack coal.

(c) The Delhi Administration is looking into the matter.
