

**t [ISSUE OF INVITATION CARDS IN HINDI FOR  
FUNCTIONS ORGANISED BY THE  
PLANNING COMMISSION**

11. SHRI A. C. GILBERT: Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:

(a) the number of functions so far organised in the year 1961, by the Planning Commission and its attached and subordinate offices for which invitation cards were issued (i) in Hindi only and (ii) both in Hindi and in English; and

(b) the reasons for not issuing the invitation cards in Hindi for those functions for which they were issued in English only?

(क) और (ख) इस वर्ष अभी तक योजना आयोग द्वारा दो समारोहों का आयोजन किया गया है। वे समारोह सितम्बर-अक्तूबर १९६१ में हुई एशिया और सुदूर पूर्व के लिये आर्थिक समीक्षण (इकाफ) की कान्फ्रेंस के सिलसिले में थे। इन दोनों समारोहों के लिये निमंत्रण-पत्र केवल अंग्रेजी में छपवाये गये थे क्योंकि वे खासतौर से विदेशी प्रतिनिधियों के लिये थे।

योजना आयोग में फिर से आदेश दे दिए गए हैं कि भविष्य में सभी समारोहों के लिये निमंत्रण-पत्र बिना किसी अपवाद के अंग्रेजी और हिन्दी में छपवाये जायें।
