RESEARCH ON PUNARNAVA

•52. SHRI BAIRAGI DWIBEDY: Will the Minister of HEALTH be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have made any research on Punarnava (*boerhavia diffusa*) and with what result; and

(b) whether there is any arrangement for conducting research on the same in the foreign countries?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH (DR. SUSHILA NAVAR): (a) The experiments made on Punarnava showed that it has no significant effect on visual acuity or refractive error of the eye. R. N. Chopra had reported an alkaloid called Punarnavine from the herb and that has been known to have diuretic action on the kidneys.

(b) The Government of India have no information.

TRAVEL AS YOU LIKE TICKETS' FOR INDIAN NATIONALS

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD AND AGRICULTURE (SHRI RAM SUBHAG SINGH): The extent of damage to crops in the Union Territory of Delhi was approximately Rs. 1,82,150/- covering an area* of about 2,935 acres.
