

to fill up the backlog vacancies of SCs and STs. The drive is still going on and is being monitored at apex level so as to complete the same expeditiously.

Special Recruitment Drive for wiping out the backlog vacancies of OBCs could not be launched due to the restriction in filling of not more than 50% reserved vacancies including the carried forward vacancies in a recruitment year. This restriction is not applicable in clearing the backlog vacancies of SCs/STs. There is no reservation for OBCs in promotion posts.
