PRODUCTION OF NON-EDIBLE OILS

154. SHRI DEOKINANDAN NARA-YAN: Will the Minister of Com-MERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state the quantity and kinds non-edible oils produced State-wise during the years 1960-61 and 1961-62?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (SHRI N. Kanungo): Neem, Mohwa, Castor, Karanja, Khaken, Sal, Undi, Kusum and Nahor are the non-edible oil seeds produced in the country. The figures of State-wise production are not available. However, the average annual production of more important nonedible oils, such as Neem, Mohwa and Castor Oil is estimated as follows for the years 1960-61 and 1961-62:-

Neem oil Approximately 3,000 tons per annum.

Mohwa oil 20,000 tons p.a. Castor oil 60,000 tons p.a.

COTTON-SEED AND COTTON-SEED OIL

155. SHRI DEOKINANDAN NARA-YAN: Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

- (a) the quantity of cotton-seeds produced in India in the years 1960-61 and 1961-62;
- (b) the quantity used for extracting oil out of it during the same period; and
- (c) the names of industries in which the oil was used and the respective quantity of oil so used in those industries in the same years?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (SHRI N. KANUNGO): (a) The production of Cotton-seeds was of the order of 18.8 lakh tons in the year 1960-61 and 15.75 lakh tons in the year 1961-62.

- (b) The approximate quantity Cotton-seeds used for extracting oil was 25 lakh tons in the year 1960-61 and 3 lakh tons in the year 1961-62.
- (c) Cotton-seed oil is mostly used in the manufacture of vanaspati and to some extent in the production of soap and for edible purposes.
