t [TRAINED PERSONNEL IN AGRICULTURE FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT WORK

314. SHRI NAWAB SINGH CHAUHAN: Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) by when the requirement for trained personnel in agriculture for the Community Development Work will be met; and

(b) what is the present requirement of such personnel and to what extent they are available?]

खाद्य तथा कृषि मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (श्री राम सुभग सिंह) : (क) कृषि में प्रशिक्षित कर्मचारियों (कृषि विस्तार अधिकारी) और सामुदायिक विकास खण्डों के लिये ग्राम स्तर कार्यकर्ताओं की आवश्यकता अक्टूबर, १९६३ तक पूरी हो जाएगी।

(ख) १-३-१९६२ को ४,२६७ कृषि विस्तार अधिकारियों और ४२,६७० ग्राम स्तर कार्यकर्ताओं की आवश्यकता थी जबकि उस समय ४,००६ कृषि विस्तार अधिकारी और ३८,७६० ग्राम स्तर कार्यकर्ता वास्तव में कार्य कर रहे थे।

trTHE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD AND AGRICULTURE (SHRI RAM SUBHAG SINGH): (a) The requirements for trained per-

sonnel in Agriculture (Agriculture Extension Officer) and Village Level Workers for Community Development Blocks will be met fully by October, 1963.

(b) As against the requirements of 4,267 Agriculture Extension Officers and 42,670 Village Level Workers as on 1st March, 1962 the number of Agriculture Extension Officers in position was 4,009 and that of Village Level Workers 38,760.]

COMPLAINT ABOUT WINTER TIMINGS OF SCHEDULE OF AIR FLIGHTS

315. SHRI N. SRI RAMA REDDY: Will the Minister of TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state whether any complaint with regard to winter timings of schedule flights to and from Madras and Bangalore to North Indian stations have been received by Government?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI AHMED MOHIUDDIN) : The Indian Airlines Corporation have reported that there have been one or two complaints with regard to winter timings of scheduled flights to and from Madras to Stations in North India. Due, however, to the limited fleet of the Corporation, it was not possible to offer, better timings. The position is likely to improve with the acquisition of more Viscounts.

SAFFRON PRODUCING CENTRE IN HIMACHAL PRADESH

316. SHRI SHIVA NAND RAMAUL: Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether a saffron producing centre has been started by the Himachal Pradesh Administration in Kin-naur District;

(b) if so, since when and at which place;

(c) what is the total amount so far spent on this centre; and

(d) to what extent progress has been made by the centre and what income, if any, has so far been yielded by the centre?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD AND AGRICULTURE (SHRI A. M. THOMAS) : (a) No. Only experimental work to ascertain the possibilities of developing saffron cultivation in Kinnaur District has been taken up.

(b) to (d) Do not arise.]

WAGONS ALLOTTED TO SOHAGPUR RAILWAY STATION

317. SHRI R. S. KHANDEKAR: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of wagons allotted per day to Sohagpur Railway Station on the Central Railway;

(b) whether Government have received any complaint from public regarding shortage of the allotment of wagons at that station; and

(c) if so, what action has been taken thereon?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI S. V. RAMASWAMY): (a) On an average 4 to 6 wagons are allotted daily at Sohagpur.

(b) Yes. Two representations were received by Central Railway Administration.

(c) Special endeavours were made by the Railway Administration to improve the wagon supply position.

DEMURRAGE CHARGED FROM GOVERNMENT

318. SHRI DAHYABHAI V. PATEL: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state the amount of demurrage collected by the Railways during the last two years from (i) Government account, i.e., goods booked for Government and (ii) Government Undertakings?

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THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI S. V. RAMASWAMY): Information is being collected from the Railways and will be placed on the Table of the Sabha.

(a) whether it is a fact that the Himachal Pradesh Administration propose to purchase the property of Maharaj Jagat Bahadur Singh at Simla for the use of the Transport Department; and

(b) if so, what action has been taken in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF SHIPPING IN THE MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI RAJ BAHADUR): (a) and (b) The information required is being collected from the Himachal Pradesh Administration and will be laid on the Table of the House as soon as it is available.
