

2. The Corporation proposes to take up exploratory work on some of the other deposits itself, and, for this purpose, a Prospecting Unit is being set up. Procurement action for equipment has been initiated; tenders received are under examination.

3. The Madhya Pradesh Electricity Board would be constructing a transmission line for supply of power to the project. It is expected that the work on the line will be completed by March, 1965. Arrangements are being made for supply of power for construction works by purchase of diesel generators.

4. A railway line to connect the project site to Vishakhapatnam port for the transport of ore is under construction and is expected to be ready by 1965. The entire plant, machinery equipment and construction materials required for the project, will have to be moved by road; from Raipur or Salur near Vishakhapatnam. The Madhya Pradesh Government, Dandakaranva Development Authority and the Ministry of Transport, Government of India, have been approached to improve the roads from the nearest rail heads, namely Raipur and Salur; work on some portions has been taken up by the Dandakaranva Development Authority and the Madhya Pradesh Government.

5. A base camp is being set up at Bhasi at the foot of the hills. A survey for locating suitable sources of water supply for the project is being taken up.]
